

DASH DISASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Carefully pry radio trim bezel outward to remove.
- Remove the (4) Phillips screws securing the radio to the sub-dash. 2.
- 3. Pull radio forward, disconnect the wire harness and antenna lead and remove radio.


DASH DISASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Remove the (2) Phillips screws located under the front edge of the radio/climate control trim bezel.
- 2. Open the pocket from below the climate controls.
- 3. Remove the plastic cover attached to the bottom of the climate controls (the retaining clips are at the front of the panel, depress backwards to release cover).
- 4. Carefully remove all harnesses from the climate control module.
- 5. Carefully pry the radio/climate control trim bezel forward just enough to remove the plastic hose from the back of the trim bezel located on the lower right side.
- 6. Disconnect the harnesses from the back of the climate controls, and remove radio/climate control trim bezel.
- 7. Remove the (4) Phillips screws securing the factory radio to the sub-dash.
- 8. Pull radio forward, disconnect the wire harness and antenna lead and remove radio.

KIT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

ISO MOUNT ONLY

- 1. Slide radio in from behind
- 2. Loosely attach ISO mountable radio to left and right bracket of kit using (4) flat head phillips screws supplied with kit or radio.
- 3. Slide radio forward or backwards for desired look and tighten mounting screws.
