

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

DASH DISASSEMBLY & RADIO REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Carefully unsnap the trim bezel from around the radio starting at the top, and remove trim bezel.
- 2. Remove the (2) Phillips screws from the radio opening securing the top of the lower console to the sub-dash.
- 3. Gently lift up and remove the ashtray/drink holder from the center console.
- 4. Remove the (2) Phillips screws under ashtray / drink holder location.
- 5. Remove the (2) Phillips screws (1) from each rear side of the center console.
- 6. Carefully lift center console upward, disconnect the light from inside the ashtray/drink holder location.
- 7. Disconnect the connections on the lighter receptacle, and remove the center console.
- 8. Remove the (4) Phillips screws securing the factory radio to the sub-dash.
- 9. Carefully pull radio forward, disconnect wire harness and antenna lead and remove the radio.

SUB-DASH PREPARATION




FROM BOTTOM EDGE FACING UP.


- 1. Remove the (2) Phillips screws from the trim bezel below the radio.
- 2. Gently lift upward from the bottom of the dash trim bezel and pull the top of the trim bezel towards you to release the (2) spring retaining clips.
- 3. Disconnect the hazard harness from the dash trim bezel and remove the trim bezel.
- 4. Remove the (4) Phillips screws securing the factory radio to the sub-dash.
- 5. Pull the radio forward, disconnect the harnesses and antenna lead and remove the radio.

- 1. Carefully remove the trim bezel from around the radio using a panel removal tool.
- 2. Remove the (4) Phillips screws securing the radio to the sub-dash.
- 3. Carefully pull the radio forward, disconnect the wire harness and antenna leads and remove the radio.



- 1. Carefully pull and remove the (3) knobs from the climate controls.
- 2. Remove the Phillips screws from each climate control knob location.
- 3. Carefully pry radio trim panel forward and remove trim.
- 4. Remove the (4) Phillips screws securing the factory radio to the subdash.
- 5. Carefully pull radio forward, disconnect the wire harness and antenna adapter and remove radio.


DIN MOUNT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Insert DIN sleeve from your new radio into the upper section of the installation kit. (This DIN sleeve comes with all new radios and slides off the back of the radio)
- 2. Depress the tabs from inside the sleeves opening upward, outward, and downward to secure sleeve to the installation kit.
- 3. Install radio into sleeve and lock into place.
- 4. Support rear of radio with back strap.

Optional use Trim Ring (ITR-890) may be used on some radios if desired.

Due to the movement of some faces on some radios our ISO Trim Ring may not be able to be used.

Your new radio must have a trim ring around the face of the radio that is designed to be easily removed. Consult your radio owner's manual.
